


A) Please confirm this is the first and only time you answer this survey. 368 responses



<u>Interpretation</u>: From the Survey it is found that 90.2% of respondents have responded for the first and only time.




Interpretation: Out of total responses, 67.6% are male whereas 32.4% are female.




<u>Interpretation</u>: It is found that maximum respondents are pursuing Bachelor's degree that is 87% and 10.8% are pursuing Master's degree.

What subject area are you currently pursuing? 370 responses





How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 369 responses



How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 369 responses





The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 368 responses






Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 366 responses

The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 366 responses


Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. 359 responses





The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. 359 responses






Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. 363 responses


The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities. 358 responses


Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.


